#### Summer Residential Governor's School

Summer Residential Governor's Schools provide rising high school juniors and seniors with intensive educational experiences in visual and performing arts; world languages; humanities; mathematics, science, and technology; or through mentorships in marine science, or engineering.

From 2022-2024, MVHS students who are accepted into and participate have a 100% acceptance rate into their top Virginia School.



#### What happens at Governor's School?

- Students live on a college or university campus for up to four weeks each summer.
- During this time, students are involved in classroom and laboratory work, field studies, research, individual and group projects and performances, and seminars with noted scholars, visiting artists, and other professionals.
- In the three mentorships, students are selected to work side-by-side with research scientists, physicians, and a variety of other professionals.
- A director and a student- staff provide supervision of students 24 hours a day, throughout the program.
- Applicants can only apply to one program and can only participate once during high school.

### Who Should Apply?

- Current FCPS sophomores and juniors
- Applicants must possess the emotional maturity, stability and self discipline to live away from home for an extended period to be successful in Governor's School.
- Regulations require a student who applies for this to be considered gifted or ready for advanced academics. FCPS embraces a talent development model of "gifted potential."
