Why are the senior dues now \$110.00 when they were \$100.00? There are some of us parents that paid the \$100.00 a few months ago.	Senior Fees has been adjusted back to the \$100. Refunds will be issued for the difference of senior dues, parking passes, lunch, and any paid field trips. Senior dues are still needed. Only half of our graduating class have paid. When do we know if our children will graduate?	Seniors' final grades are due on June 1 <sup>st</sup> ; afterwards all seniors will be processed to determine who graduates in June. Students' transcripts will be finalized and will show "graduated". School counselors are in touch with students of concern now and will notify them and their parents if they do not meet graduation requirements in June. These students should continue their classes in order to graduate in August.
